

Subject: OMM602 – OP&P Online Clerkship Requirement

**OMM 602, OP&P Online, IS A CLERKSHIP GRADUATION REQUIREMENT.** This requirement is intended to contribute to the process of integrating OP&P/OMM into the recognized clerkship courses as well as helping to equip you for the two COMLEX, Level 2 examinations by enabling you to review key concepts and principles related to osteopathic medicine.

In order to meet this clerkship requirement, you need to successfully complete OMM602 by receiving a passing score of at least 70% on each of four online content exams. There is no limit to the number of times that you may attempt to pass an online exam. However, you will receive a new set of questions for each attempt. **You will have until August 20, 2009 to successfully complete all four of the online content exams.** To ensure that you receive proper credit, **you must print out the corrected answer sheet for each of the 4 exams and submit this packet of documentation to the main office of the Department of Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine at A439 East Fee Hall.**

You will be officially enrolled in the OP&P Online Clerkship Requirement (OMM602) in the Summer Session of 2009, but you can access the online content and each of the four online exams at any time by activating your online account. **To activate your online account, contact Rick Hallgren via e-mail [hallgren@msu.edu](mailto:hallgren@msu.edu)** with the heading “Class of 2010” in the subject line. Additional information on getting started will then be sent to you via e-mail.

The content of these materials is clinically focused and builds upon basic science content that rationalize the basis for using specific clinical procedures so that a physician may know why they are doing OMM, as well as knowing how to do it. The basic science materials are organized so that the student can access them when, and if, needed, but the student does not have to “plod” through them if they already have an adequate knowledge base.
